

Directions to NC State Centennial Campus, Engineering Building II (EBII)

Centennial Campus is located inside the Raleigh city limits, just two miles from downtown and the State Capitol. Interstate 40 provides a direct connection to Research Triangle Park and RDU International Airport, both located 15 miles west of Centennial Campus.

I-40 coming east

Take Gorman Street exit. Turn left onto Gorman. Turn right at second light onto Avent Ferry Road. Pass Trailwood Drive (light) and turn right at next light onto Varsity Drive.

I-40 coming west

Take Lake Wheeler Road Exit; turn right onto Lake Wheeler. Turn left at first light onto Centennial Parkway; follow to end. Turn left on Avent Ferry Rd. Turn left at first light onto Varsity Drive.

Inside the Raleigh Beltline

Take Western Boulevard to Avent Ferry Road. Turn south (downhill). Turn left at the second light onto Varsity Drive.

From Sheraton, Downtown Raleigh

Head south on S. Salisbury St. toward W. Cabarrus St. Turn right at Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. Continue onto Western Boulevard to Avent Ferry Road. Turn left onto Avent Ferry (south). Turn left at the second light onto Varsity Drive.

After turning onto Varsity Drive, travel straight ahead and proceed to the 4-way stop sign. This is the intersection of Varsity Drive and Main Campus Drive. Go straight through this intersection (you will notice the LexisNexis corporate offices located on your left) to the next stop sign, which is the intersection with Partners Way. The building immediately in front of you is EBII. Take a left at the stop sign. The first parking deck entrance on the left is the parking deck for LexisNexis – please do NOT park there. Look for the Pay Lot signs of the Partners Way Parking Deck (last parking deck entrance on left) and park there. This deck has a self-pay machine; it costs \$3/hour, \$2/consecutive partial hour up to \$15/vehicle/day and only accepts credit card payments using a Master Card, Visa, Discover or American Express – no cash is accepted.

After parking, exit deck, cross the street, walk toward EBII and down a short flight of stairs near the blue light. At the bottom of the stairs, turn left onto the concrete walkway to the EBII Breezeway and enter the East Wing Atrium. A member of your student team will meet you there and escort you to the meeting room.
